What will you be doing ?

- Set up and take down the start and finish area
- Clear up the main event area and clear away any litter

- Practical skills
- A willingness to work as part of a team
- Enthusiasm and a pro-active attitude
- A flexible approach
- Be physically active as this role may involve some heavy lifting

How much time do you need to commit ?

As Shine is a night-time event we require individuals to choose shift times that suit their availability. Please note due to health and safety regulations and for your welfare we recommend that you do not register for consecutive shifts.
