What will you be doing ?

You may be asked to:

- Help set up the start/finish area
- Guide participants to the start line
- Hand participants their medals and water when they finish
- Congratulate the participants when they finish
- Keep the flow of participants moving through the finish area
- Clear away the finish area and ensure that the area is clear of rubbish

What skills do you need ?

- Great interpersonal and communication skills
- Practical skills and initiative
- A willingness to work as part of a team
- Enthusiasm and pro-active attitude
- A flexible approach

How much time do you need to commit ?

As shine is a night-time event we require individuals to choose shift times to suit their availability.

Sunday 18th April: Midnight – 06:00

Sunday 18th April: 06:00 – 12:00
